

This course is participating in the Inclusive Access Program through the UVA Bookstore.

What is Inclusive Access?

Inclusive Access is a collaborative affordability initiative between the UVA Bookstore, faculty, and publishers. Students enrolled in an Inclusive Access course will receive access to required digital course materials by the first day of class at a reduced cost compared to the national average.

Prices will be listed in a welcome email you will receive one to two weeks prior to the start of classes. Students who add a class close to or after the start of the semester will receive an email 24 hours after they are enrolled.

How is Inclusive Access billed?

You will be automatically charged on your SIS account for this digital content. The billing description will show the department, course and section number. For example, a charge for PLAP 3160 section 001 would include the reference number PLAP3160001.

What if I drop the course?

Students who drop the course within the first two weeks of class will receive a credit on their SIS account. YOU DO NOT HAVE TO NOTIFY THE BOOKSTORE IF YOU DROP THE COURSE. This is an automated process.

What if I am on the Waitlist?

Waitlisted students are included in the program the same as enrolled students. They have the same access and are charged on their student accounts for the materials. If you never end up enrolling in the class, you do not need to opt-out to avoid being charged.

Waitlisted students will be cleared in SIS shortly after the add/drop period ends, which will drop them from Inclusive Access and credit their accounts for any charges.

Can I opt out of Inclusive Access?

Students may choose to opt out of the program. Opting out does not mean you are dropping the course. It simply means you are choosing not to receive the digital content from the bookstore and you must find another way to acquire it in order to complete required homework assignments. Students have within the first two weeks of class to opt out and receive a credit to their SIS account. Instructions on how to opt out will be emailed shortly before classes start.

The Opt-Out Deadline is

Some COMM, ECE, MSE, and PHYS classes have custom materials that are mandatory for enrolled students and cannot be opted out of. These are processed separately, so the charge will appear later than most Inclusive Access charges and specific class information may not be listed with the charge on SIS.

How do I access the required digital content?

There is a tool on the Navigation Menu of your Canvas course called **UVA Bookstore Inclusive Access**. This is where you can find the “Read Now” button for ebooks as well as an opt-out button. For courseware, such as Mastering, Connect, Revel, MyLab, WebAssign, WileyPlus, TopHat, etc., you will receive an email by the start of the semester that will instruct you on how to access the required digital course materials. You may not be able to access the digital content until the first day of class.
